Impressions

- What impressions do you get of the writer?
- What impressions do you get of an organisation or people?
- What impressions you get of a place?
- What impressions does this article create?
- What are your thoughts and feelings about...?



Thoughts and feelings

- What are the writer's attitudes to...?
- What are the writer's opinions of...?
- What are the writer's thoughts and feelings about...?



Intended audience

- Who is the text aimed at?



The How Question

- How does the writer try to encourage/interest/argue?
- How does this text try to persuade/sell/influence /show?
- How...
