## Uniform Policy

Montgomery High School believes very strongly in a policy of full school uniform for all students in Years 7 to 11 and in maintaining the very highest standards of dress and appearance appropriate to the workplace. These standards will be best achieved by the by the full commitment of all students, staff, parents and governors to the following agreed principles and practices:

- All students will be expected to wear full school uniform from the beginning of term and at all times when involved in school business, including on journeys to and from school
- Footwear should be chosen that is suitable for healthy bone development and should be appropriate for everyday wear in the workplace. Considerable movement, both indoors and outdoors is necessary, including the use of several staircases. Shoes must therefore have flat or very low heels and be securely fastened at all times.
- Jewellery should be restricted to wearing a wristwatch, a single ring and one small earring or stud per ear. Earrings and watches must be removed for PE lessons and watches for Design and Technology lessons when safety apply.
- Discreet make-up is permitted.
- Hairstyles which are extreme in colour or style are discouraged. Hair accessories should be simple and unobtrusive. Long hair must be tied back for reasons of safety and hygiene.
- All clothing and other items should be clearly marked with the student's name. Labelling must be durable for washing and cleaning purposes. The school has no legal liability for lost or stolen clothing or other items of equipment. It is suggested that household insurance be extended to include 'All-risks' on items of clothing and personal effects to cover such losses.
- School bags should be of a reasonable size in order to carry any school kit or books. Large bags can cause accidents on staircases and in crowded corridors.
- Garments have been chosen to enable parents to buy school clothing at economic prices from local suppliers and the Montgomery Uniform Shop (contact via School Reception on 01253 356271)

Parents and students are urged to note and follow the spirit as well as the letter of the School Uniform Policy. Our aim is simply to give all students the opportunity to look both smartly and appropriately dressed for the workplace, in a style that is of reasonable cost and durability. The school will take action when students do not adhere to our school uniform code.

**MAIN UNIFORM - THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE ESSENTIAL:**

- Indoor Wear:*** Montgomery High School blazer with logo  
Plain white shirt  
School tie with logo  
Charcoal grey/black trousers  
Plain black or brown shoes (boots and trainers are not permitted)
- Optional:*** V-necked maroon jumper or sleeveless pullover with logo
- Outdoor Wear:*** Plain, self-coloured coat

**PHYSICAL EDUCATION - THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE ESSENTIAL:**

- Indoor Wear:*** White polo shirt with logo  
Black shorts  
Pumps or training shoes, not training boots  
White socks
- Outdoor Wear:*** Reversible maroon shirt  
Black shorts  
Maroon and white socks  
Football Boots
- Optional:*** Montgomery High School PE tracksuit  
Shin pads and gum shields advised
- General:*** Extreme hairstyles are discouraged.  
All P.E. kit should be labelled.  
An apron is required for Design and Technology lessons.  
A suitable bag is needed for books and equipment.
- Jewellery:*** Only a wrist watch and a single ring may be worn. Boys with pierced ears may wear **one** stud/ring with diameter no greater than 1cm in each ear. These must be removed for PE and games and are brought to school at the owner's risk. No other piercing of the face is permitted, e.g. nose, eyebrow, tongue on grounds of health and safety.

There should be no deviation from uniform as listed above. I hope that all parents will support the school's efforts to maintain a high standard in matters of uniform and join our pride in the smart appearance of our students.

**MAIN UNIFORM - THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE ESSENTIAL:**

- Indoor Wear:*** Montgomery High School blazer, with logo  
Maroon skirt **or** (black bootleg trousers which are optional).  
Revere collar blouse white.  
White socks/black or self-coloured tights.  
Sensible plain black or brown shoes (high heels, boots and training shoes are not permitted).
- Optional:*** V-necked maroon jumper or sleeveless pullover with logo
- Outdoor Wear:*** Plain, self-coloured coat.

**PHYSICAL EDUCATION - THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE ESSENTIAL:**

- White polo shirt with logo.  
White socks.  
Black shorts.  
Maroon and white football socks.  
Football boots.  
Pumps or training shoes, not training boots.
- Optional:*** Montgomery High School PE tracksuit.  
Shin pads and gum shields advised.
- General:*** Extreme hairstyles are discouraged.  
All P.E. kit should be labelled.  
An apron is required for Design and Technology lessons.

- Jewellery:*** Only a wrist watch and one plain signet ring may be worn. Girls with pierced ears may wear **one** stud/ring with diameter no greater than 1cm in each ear. These must be removed for PE and games and are brought to school at the owner's risk. No other piercing of the face is permitted, e.g. nose, eyebrow, tongue on grounds of health and safety.
- Cosmetics:*** Discreet make-up is allowed.
